

1. Team responsibilities:

To work together to get their best results. All team members should know the plan for the upcoming end. The team can pass messages about changes to the approach for the next end or comments on ice condition changes as the game progresses.

Skip's responsibilities:

**to indicate the next shot to be played indicating the speed and the turn;
as line caller may also indicate further details of the shot such as where to roll to;
whether it is better to be shorter or longer;
whether it is better to roll to the left or right.**

The skip works to use the skills of the team to best advantage.

Sweepers' responsibilities:

**to continuously monitor the ice for speed changes;
to observe the opponents rock speed;
to observe the target brush placement;
to sweep when the line caller requests;
to stop sweeping when the line caller requests;
to report rock speed to the line caller;
to sweep draw shots that are not going fast enough to get to the target location.**

Thrower's responsibilities:

**to understand what result is being requested;
to confer with the sweepers and skip in order to understand the speed of the requested throw;
whether the thrown stone is better shorter or longer and to the left or the right of the indicated target.**
