NCC Director of Curling

Purpose

Provides the primary link between the leagues and the Board of Directors. He/She adjudicates issues, brings concerns to the Board, and maintains communication with league representatives. As a member of the Board, the Director of Curling provides valuable insights to the overall management of the Nanaimo Curling Centre.

Responsibilities

- Introduce yourself to league reps in September and maintain contacts throughout the curling season.
- Contact league reps in mid-March to confirm reps or their replacements for the next curling season. Pass information to office.
- Attend monthly Board meetings and bring forward any league concerns.
- Act as a liaison between the league reps and the Board of Directors.
- Educate and create awareness to league reps on operating policies such as spare fees, buzzer times, etc.
- Assist the Past President in identifying your successor.
- Assist in identifying your successor to the Board
