### Did you know...

If you touch your own stone (called "burning") before the hog line, it is immediately taken out of play. If you burn it after the hog line, it is allowed to come to rest. Then the opposition (non-offending team) can choose to do one of three things: (1) leave things as they are, (2) remove it and put all stones back as close as possible to the previous position, or (3) attempt to put things as they might have been had the stone not been touched.

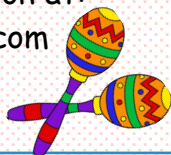
