

PICK A NUMBER PERCENTAGE DRAW RULES AND REGULATIONS

In support of the Nanaimo Curling Club (NCC), we are pleased to announce our Pick A Number Percentage Draw Raffle. In accordance with the rules and regulations of the BC Gaming Policy and Enforcement Branch (BCGP&EB), the following applies:

1. The Pick A Number Percentage Draw Raffle will be open to the public. Tickets can be purchased online on the NCC website or Facebook page until 2 PM on draw dates.
2. Tickets cost \$5.00 per ticket, no refunds. You may purchase more than one ticket but you must be 19 years or older and a resident of BC in order to purchase tickets.
3. All tickets are numbered and have matching stubs. You may purchase any number of tickets but they are only valid for the next scheduled weekly Draw Date.
4. Sales for each draw will begin on Thursday of each week with the weekly draw occurring at 3 PM on Wednesday of each week until the conclusion of the draw on December 16, 2020.
5. Each weekly draw winner will receive 25% of the weekly sales as their prize.
6. When purchasing your weekly draw tickets to participate in the event, you will also have an opportunity to participate in our door prize free give away by choosing a number between 1 and 50. This number will entitle you to a chance to win a free prize of cash from the NCC. The NCC may determine this cash prize as 25% of all the sales from the Pick a Number Percentage Draw up to the date of the draw. A separate draw will be done after the percentage draw from numbers 1 to 50 in a bucket. If the number matches the number chosen for the Percentage Draw winning ticket, the Percentage Draw winner will also win the free prize.
7. Each number drawn from the free prize bucket will be removed each week reducing the numbers available to choose for the free draw when you purchase your Percentage Draw Raffle tickets for the next weeks draw.
8. If the door prize is awarded before the last draw date, the NCC may calculate the next door prize as 25% of the remaining draw dates.
9. If the door prize is not awarded before or at the last draw date, the NCC will draw from the remaining weekly percentage draw tickets until a ticket is drawn that matches the number ticket drawn for the free door prize.

EXAMPLE: Joe purchases 4 tickets for the percentage draw in the first week's draw. When he purchases his tickets, he gets to choose a number between 1 and 50 for each ticket purchased to the draw event. He chooses 4, 17, 35 and 45. On the draw date, his ticket is pulled for the Percentage draw. He wins 25% of that week's draw sales. The winning ticket is associated with the number 17 he chose for that ticket. The NCC now draws a number from the free draw bucket. The number pulled is 24. Joe does not win the free door prize. NCC removes 24 from the number draw bucket and all of the Percentage draw tickets are now invalid.

During the next weekly Percentage draw, Joe decides to buy 4 tickets for the percentage draw and also gets to choose 4 numbers for the free door prize draw. He chooses 4, 17, 35 and 45 again. He cannot choose 24. Joe is super lucky and his ticket is drawn from the Percentage Draw bucket again! He wins 25% of that week's draw sales. This time Joe's ticket drawn is associated with the number 35. The NCC draws a number from the free door prize number bucket and it is 35!! Joe wins the free door prize that may be determined by the NCC to equal 25% of the weekly draw sales from last week and this week.

A new weekly percentage draw begins and the previous week's tickets are now invalid. The 25% weekly prize is given away to ticket purchasers for the next 8 weeks but nobody chooses the correct free draw number until the eighth week. The weekly percentage draw winner happens to pick the right free draw number and wins the free prize determined by the NCC and may equal 25% of the last 8 week's percentage draw sales.
